## THE ADVANTAGES

1. **THE WHOLE BIBLE WILL BE READ THROUGH IN AN ORDERLY MANNER IN THE COURSE OF A YEAR.** - The Old Testament once, the New Testament and Acts twice. I fear many have never read the whole Bible, and yet it is all equally divine. *"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction and instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be perfect."*
2. **TIME WILL NOT BE WASTED IN CHOOSING WHAT PORTIONS TO READ.** - Often believers are at a loss to determine what to read and when to read it. Here the question will be solved at once in a very simple manner.
3. **THE SWEET BOND OF CHRISTIAN LOVE AND UNITY WILL BE STRENGTHENED.** - We shall often be led to think of those dear brothers and sisters in the Lord, who agree to join with us in reading these portions. We shall oftener be led to agree on earth, touching something we shall ask of God. We shall pray over the same promises, mourn over the same confessions, praise God in the same songs, and be nourished by the same words of eternal life.

## DIRECTIONS

1. The centre column contains the day of the month. The first two columns contain the Main Plan chapters to be read. The two last columns contain extra portions that may be read.
2. The portions read would be greatly illuminated if they were preceded by a moment's silent prayer - *"Open Thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of Thy law."* (Ps. cxix. 18).
3. Let the conversation around the family and campus meal tables frequently turn upon the chapter read. Thus every meal will be truly a means of Grace, being sanctified by the Word and prayer.
